Chief Trabert explained the possibility of moving Aberdeen dispatchers over to the new County Emergency Operations Center (EOC) which was built to house dispatch county-wide. The goal would be to consolidate dispatching services under the direction and management of the County. Further consideration of costs, negotiations, and approval were needed from Harford County leaders.

Mr. Robertson and Mr. Torster discussed the prospect of purchasing water from Havre de Grace. Current water agreements, engineering concepts, water charges, and associated costs were considered.

Mr. Robertson and Mr. Hess reported on meetings held concerning the layout and design of the Middleton Road extension. The Council considered the public benefits, business growth, and directed the City Manager concerning future negotiations.
