SECTION 1: BE IT ENACTED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABERDEEN that the "City of Aberdeen Budget Fiscal Year 2015-2016" originally adopted by Ordinance No. 15-O-05 and amended is further amended as follows: 1. Decrease the Payroll Related, Dept. No. 161, appropriation for "Medical Insurance" from \$1,702,228 to \$1,551,228. 2. Increase the Government Buildings, Dept. No. 106, appropriation for "Information Technology" from \$225,000 to \$330,000. 3. Increase the Government Buildings, Dept. No. 106, appropriation for "Municipal Buildings" from \$308,000 to \$353,000. 4. Increase the Debt Service - Interest, Dept. No. 141, appropriation for "Loan Fees" from \$22,844 to \$23,844. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED BY THE MAYOR AND **SECTION 2:** COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABERDEEN that the sums and amounts reflected in Section 1 of this Ordinance are hereby appropriated for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2016. SECTION 3: AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED BY THE MAYOR AND

COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABERDEEN that this Emergency Ordinance shall become

effective on the day following its adoption by Council.
