SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABERDEEN, that Sections 43-3 and 43-4 of the Code of the City of Aberdeen (2010 Edition as amended), Chapter 43, Ethics, are repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Chapter 43. ETHICS § 43-3. Conflicts of interest. **E.** Post-employment limitations and restrictions. (2) Until the conclusion of the next regular term that begins after an elected official leaves office, a former member of the Council may not assist or represent another party for compensation, OR OTHERWISE ACT AS A LOBBYIST, in a matter that is the subject of legislative action. K. A PERSON WHO IS REGULATED AS A LOBBYIST UNDER SECTION 3-107 MAY NOT, FOR A PERIOD OF ONE CALENDAR YEAR AFTER TERMINATING LOBBYING REGISTRATION, BECOME EMPLOYED BY THE TOWN FOR COMPENSATION OF MORE THAN \$30,000 PER YEAR AND, WHILE SO EMPLOYED, PARTICIPATE IN A CASE, CONTRACT OR OTHER SPECIFIC MATTER IN WHICH HE OR SHE PREVIOUSLY REPRESENTED ANOTHER PERSON IN CONNECTION WITH THAT MATTER WHILE REGISTERED AS A LOBBYIST. § 43-4 Financial disclosure - local elected officials and candidates to be local elected officials. C. Public record. (2) Financial disclosure statements shall be made available during normal office hours for examination and copying by the public subject to reasonable fees and administrative procedures established by the Ethics Commission. NOTWITHSTANDING THE FOREGOING, THE COMMISSION MAY NOT MAKE AVAILABLE FOR EXAMINATION AND COPYING BY THE PUBLIC ANY PORTION OF A FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE STATEMENT THAT CONTAINS THE HOME ADDRESS OF AN INDIVIDUAL.
