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34	Defini	<u>tions</u>
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36	1)	Residential Real Property – Real property that is owned and used as the employee's
37		primary residence.
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39	<u>Scope</u>	and Conditions
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41		A rebate shall be on an annual basis.
42 43	2)	The annual rebate shall be an amount equal to \$300 or the City property tax levied on the residential real property for that year, whichever is less.
44	3)	To be eligible for a rebate an individual must be employed and remain employed as a
45		full-time employee of the City of Aberdeen.
46	4)	An employee shall apply for the property tax rebate on a form prescribed by the City
47		Manager, and shall provide documentation satisfactory to the City Manager as to the
48		qualification of the employee and the property for the rebate.
49	5)	An application for a rebate must be submitted annually, within 60 days of payment of the
50		real property tax, and must include proof of payment of the tax. An application shall be
51		reviewed by the City to determine if the property qualifies for a rebate, and the employee
52		will be notified of the City's decision.
53	6)	An employee's eligibility for a property tax rebate shall terminate when the employee
54		sells the property, or upon termination of employment, whichever comes first.
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56 **<u>Timing of Reimbursement</u>**

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58 An eligible employee will be reimbursed once an application, showing proof of payment, is 59 approved. When property tax is paid in installments the City may pay the rebate in pro-rata 60 installments.

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62 W-2 Treatment of Rebate

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64 A property tax rebate will be reported to the IRS on the employee's W-2 as income.

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66 **Program Continuation**

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68 The program and any property tax rebate payments are dependent upon the availability of funds
