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**RESOLUTION NO. 20-R-04**

**DEED MODIFICATION OF 34 N. PHILADELPHIA BOULEVARD**

**A Resolution authorizing the Mayor and City Council of Aberdeen, Maryland to modify the contract between the City of Aberdeen and Keyona Investors LLC that outlines a deed restriction for the property at 34 N. Philadelphia Boulevard, Aberdeen, Maryland, 21001.**

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Council of Aberdeen sold the above property 8 March 2018 to Keyona Investors LLC; and

**WHEREAS**, at that time, the Council entered a deed restriction that requires, "...for a period of ten (10) years from the issuance of a certificate of occupancy for the Property, use of the Property for senior residential purposes, including senior apartments and senior day care, related commercial office or medical space, or multi-family apartments at rental or sale market rates consistent with other comparable senior or multi-family residential properties in the Aberdeen area."

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Council have been briefed that Keyona Investors LLC intends to sell 34 N. Philadelphia Boulevard to Mohammed M. Chaudry, MD and associates for the purposes of converting 34 N. Philadelphia Boulevard into a medical treatment facility and/or medical related activities facility; and

**WHEREAS**, Dr. Chaudry has requested and will need the existing deed restriction waived to authorize this type use; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Council received Dr. Chaudry's information and briefing at the 12 October 2020 Council Meeting; and

**WHEREAS**, all members of the Council reflected their thoughts and approval to adjust the deed restriction to allow the type of uses Dr. Chaudry has outlined; and

1           **WHEREAS**, it is the Mayor and City Council’s continuing guidance to support this  
2 initiative.  
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4           **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Mayor and City Council authorizes  
5 the City Manager to modify that portion of the deed restriction as provided in the 8 March 2018  
6 Contract of Sale to read as: “Buyer shall enter into a deed restriction for the Property that  
7 requires, for a period of ten (10) years from the issuance of a certification of occupancy for the  
8 Property, use of Property shall be for medical treatment and/or medically related commercial  
9 office space.  
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11           **AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that this Resolution shall take effect from the  
12 date of its adoption.
