THE DRIVER OR OWNER OF ANY TRAILER OR TRAILER-TYPE VEHICLE 25 В. 15 F. A VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION IS A MUNICIPAL INFRACTION 16 PUNISHABLE BY A FINE OF \$100. EACH DAY THAT A VIOLATION 17 CONTINUES IS A SEPARATE OFFENSE.

A POLICE OFFICER MAY ORDER THE IMPOUNDMENT OF A TRAILER, A 20 TRAILER-TYPE VEHICLE OR A MOTOR HOME PARKED IN VIOLATION OF 21 THIS SECTION IF PRIOR WRITTEN NOTICE HAS BEEN PROVIDED TO THE 22 DRIVER OR OWNER THAT THE TRAILER, TRAILER-TYPE VEHICLE OR MOTOR HOME IS SUBJECT TO IMPOUNDMENT IF NOT MOVED WITHIN 23 24 24 HOURS AND THE LOCATION TO WHICH THE TRAILER, TRAILER-TYPE 25 VEHICLE OR MOTOR HOME WILL BE REMOVED. NOTICE SHALL BE 26 SECURELY AFFIXED TO THE TRAILER, TRAILER-TYPE VEHICLE OR 27 MOTOR HOME. PROMPTLY AFTER IMPOUNDMENT, THE CITY SHALL MAKE AND DOCUMENT REASONABLE EFFORTS TO NOTIFY THE 28 29 OWNER AS TO THE LOCATION OF THE TRAILER, TRAILER-TYPE VEHICLE OR MOTOR HOME. THE DRIVER OR OWNER OF ANY TRAILER, 30 TRAILER-TYPE VEHICLE OR MOTOR HOME SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE 31 32 FOR ANY TOWING, IMPOUNDMENT AND STORAGE FEES INCURRED.
