BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SECTION 1. ABERDEEN, that Section 250-15 of the Code of the City of Aberdeen (2010 Edition as amended), Chapter 250. ENVIRONMENTAL CONTROL, Article V, Vegetation, is repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

If the property owner, tenant and/or occupant fails to cut, trim or remove the vegetation 20 within seven calendar days of date of notice, OR WITHIN TWO CALENDAR DAYS IN 21 THE CASE OF HABITUAL VIOLATORS, the City shall abate the violation by use of City 22 employees and equipment or by contract with private contractors. 23 24 25 26 H. AS USED IN THIS SECTION, A "HABITUAL OFFENDER" IS A PROPERTY FOR 27 28 WHICH THE CITY HAS ISSUED IN THE SAME CALENDAR YEAR MORE THAN TWO NOTICES OF ABATEMENT UNDER SUBSECTION C. OF THIS SECTION. 29 30 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY 31 32 **OF ABERDEEN**, that this Ordinance shall become effective at the expiration of twenty (20) calendar days following adoption. 33
