AN ORDINANCE concerning

AMENDMENT OF FY 2018 BUDGET (6)

FOR the purpose of amending the adopted budget for the City of Aberdeen for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2018, to appropriate for certain purposes certain funds from the City's unrestricted fund balances, and add additional revenue to the General Fund and generally related to amendment of the City's FY 2018 budget.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABERDEEN that the "City of Aberdeen Budget Fiscal Year 2017-2018" adopted by Ordinance No. 17-O-11 and amended is further amended as follows:

1. Increase the Police Dept. No. 110, appropriation for "Police Cars" from \$0 to \$839,991.
2. Increase General Fund "Loan Proceeds" Revenue No. 40900 from \$0 to \$839,991.
3. Increase Total General Fund appropriation from \$18,116,030 to \$18,956,021.
4. Increase the Total Revenues General Fund from \$18,116,030 to \$18,956,021.

SECTION 2: AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABERDEEN that the sums and amounts reflected in Section 1 of this Ordinance are hereby appropriated for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2018.

SECTION 3: AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABERDEEN that this Emergency Ordinance shall become effective on the day following its adoption by Council.


