A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ABERDEEN FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUPPORTING THE COMMUNITY LEGACY APPLICATION (2)

Resolution of the City of Aberdeen is approving the application and receipt of financing for a Community Legacy Project (the "Project") further described in the Community Legacy Application (the "Application"), to be financed either directly by the Department of Housing and Community Development of the State of Maryland (the "Department"), or through other departments or agencies of the State of Maryland.

WHEREAS, the City of Aberdeen recognizes that there is a significant need for reinvestment and revitalization of the communities in Harford County/Aberdeen; and

WHEREAS, the Department, either through Community Legacy or through other programs of the Department, or in cooperation with other State departments or agencies, may provide some or all of the financing for the Project (the "Project Financing") in order to assist in making it financially feasible; and

WHEREAS, the Project, located within a designated priority funding area under Section 5-7B-02 of the Smart Growth Act, is located in a Sustainable Community, as identified in the Sustainable Communities Act of 2010, and the Project will conform to the local zoning code; and

WHEREAS, the applicable law and regulations require approval of the Community Legacy Project and the Project Financing by the City of Aberdeen and, where appropriate, by the chief elected executive official of the local subdivision.
