## 2. Planning

- a) Wellhead Protection Ordinance Revisions Mr. Miller talked about wellhead protection history and amendments proposed for Chapter 524 of the Code.
- b) Integrated Business District Ms. Grover explained that the Development Code needs revising and presented a draft ordinance.
- c) Boat and RV Storage Mr. Miller presented a rewrite of a draft ordinance pertaining to storage and size of RVs, campers, boats, and trailers.

## 3. Other

- a) National League of Cities Committee Appointment Mr. Miller stated that the Mayor has been appointed by the National League of Cities as Chair of the Military Communities Council. The Mayor said that much of the work is done by conference calls and the committee is concerned with veteran issues.
- b) Moose Property Façade and Other Improvements –The purchased building is part of the Transit Oriented Development area and is being considered for reuse as an ordnance museum with the prospect that it will increase tourism to the city. A local architect drew a rendition of the building and was aided with the use of an unmanned drone. Inspection of the building is necessary in order to bring it up to code standards.
- c) Festival Park Naming Contest A non-binding contest will be held to rename Festival Park in order to boost the Council's vision of the park being the epicenter of city activities. The name should also merge well with the Station Square concept.
- d) The Mayor said that he attended a meeting with the new Governor who plans to restore full funding to State Highway User Revenues over the next couple years.
