
WINDOW DECORATING CONTEST

DEADLINE - WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 30, 2016, 5:00 PM

- 1. The theme for Christmas Street is "Christmas Stories"
- 2. Miniature white lights and natural looking artificial greens **must** be used in the display.
- 3. All window assignments must be **made with the chairman**. If you have made previous arrangements with a store owner, please advise the chairman as soon as possible. Other entrants should contact the chairman for a window assignment. If you have entered and find you are unable to participate, please notify the chairman as soon as possible.
- 4. All windows must be completed by 2:00 p.m., Friday, December 2ND, 2016, and will be judged at 6 p.m. that evening, lighted.
- 5. Check in with the merchant whose window you are decorating to find out when it will be convenient for you to begin work. You need to find out what type platform and back-drop are available, if any. Discuss your lighting with the merchant (outlets available) and make plans for using a timer (if possible) to turn the lights on in the evening.
- 6. Participants are responsible for their own lights, back-drops (if none there), extension cords, timers, platforms (if none there), and working supplies (tapes, tacks, etc.)
- 7. A card large enough to be seen from the sidewalk should be placed in your window with your window title. Your name should be folded back and not revealed until after the judging.
- 8. No advertising of commercial enterprises or products is permitted.
- 9. You should check your window periodically to be sure that your lighting system is working and that everything is in place. Leave your name and phone number with the merchant in case you need to be contacted.
- 10. Prize winners for the window contest will be announced at the Tree Lighting Ceremony following the parade. Prize money will be awarded and prize ribbons will be placed in the windows.
- 11. Windows will be judged in three categories:
 - (1) Adult Clubs or Organizations
 - (2) Youth Groups (school groups, scouts, church groups, etc.)
 - (3) Businesses
 - Three (3) FIRST PLACE awards of \$200.00 (one in each category)
 - Three (3) SECOND PLACE awards of \$150.00(one in each category)
 - Three (3) THIRD PLACE awards of \$100.00 (one in each category)
 - HONORABLE MENTIONS may also be awarded.
- 12. Window display will be judged on a scale from 0-10 using the following criteria:

(of a possible 40 points, winners must earn a minimum of 20 points)

- a. Use of Theme
- b. Use of white miniature lights
- c. Use of natural looking artificial greens
- d. Display presentation (background, lighting, total look, neatness)
- 13. Windows should be dismantled by **End of December.**

GUIDELINES FOR PARADE

FLOATS & WALKING GROUPS

- 1. The theme for Christmas Street is "Christmas Stories"
- 2. A float may consist of any display that can be pulled or is self-propelled, not to exceed the normal width of one lane of a city street. This includes pick-up trucks, and farm trailers at least 4' x 4', but **NOT** to exceed 45' overall in length.
- 3. Floats must be decorated in accordance with the Christmas Street theme to qualify for judging.
- 4. All entries must be designed to be seen by all sides of the street.
- 5. NO TRINKETS, CANDY, OR GUM WILL BE THROWN FROM ANY PARADE ENTRY. FAILURE TO COMPLY WILL RESULT IN EJECTION FROM PARADE.
- 6. Float must not be blatantly commercial, but may display a sign of a commercial nature so long as it does not take away from the theme of the float.
- 7. Cash prizes for **FLOATS** will be awarded as follows in three separate categories (Youth Groups; Adult Groups; and Youth/Adult combined groups). Each category receiving a first, second, and third prize.

FIRST PLACE award of \$125.00;

SECOND PLACE award of \$100.00;

THIRD PLACE award of \$75.00.

8. Cash prizes for **WALKING GROUPS** will be awarded as follows in THREE separate categories (Youth Groups; Adult Groups; and Youth /Adult Combined). Each category receiving a first, second, and third prize.


FIRST PLACE award of \$100.00

SECOND PLACE award of \$75.00

THIRD PLACE award of \$50.00

- 9. The decision of the parade committee is final if any question should arise.
- 10. All entries must be in to the committee no later than November 25, 2016
- 11. The Appearance and Preservation Committee brings in Santa and Mrs. Claus. NO other Santa or Mrs. Claus is to be in the parade.

- 13. FLOATS AND WALKING GROUPS MUST USE THE THEME to be judged on a scale of 1-10. For a possible of 40 points, winners must earn a minimum of 20 points.
