Trash Day Collection Exceptions and Important Dates.

Have all containers placed curbside by 5AM.



05/30/22	Memorial Day (Monday)	Trash/recycling/bulk delayed one day.
07/04/22	Independence Day (Monday)	Trash/recycling/bulk delayed one day.
09/05/22	Labor Day (Monday)	Trash/recycling/bulk delayed one day.
11/24/22	Thanksgiving Day (Thursday)	Thursday collection moved to Friday 11/25, Friday collection moved to Saturday 11/26.
12/26/22	Christmas Day obs (Monday)	Trash/recycling/bulk delayed one day.

All operations will run on a regular schedule unless stated above.

No container shall exceed 64 gallons.

Yard Waste

April through June and October through December on the 3rd Saturday of each month **EXCEPT APRIL.**

Yard Waste can be taken **free of charge** to the Harford County Mulch and Compost facility year around. They can be contacted at 410-638-3018.

Acceptable	Not Acceptable
Grass clippings, brush branches, hedge trimmings, whole Christmas trees and leaves. Waste MUST be bundled.	Tree limbs larger than 6-inch diameter, logs or stumps, Noxious weeds, Poison Ivy, Oak or Sumac, animal waste, diseased or infested plant material, garbage, rocks, bricks, dirt, construction debris, lawn ornaments and bamboo*. NO PLASTIC BAGS. * Bundle bamboo and place with trash.

Remember the 4 B's of Recycling and Yard Waste

Blue (Recycling)
Brown (Yard Waste)
Bagged
Bundled

- Place in Brown Toter container not to exceed 64 gallons.
- CANNOT** exceed 60 lbs or 4 ft in length.
- Bundle with twine or cotton rope.
- Do not place plastic bags inside of paper bags.

Did you know about our FREE CHIPPER service? We will bring our chipper truck to you.



- A free service offered year round every Tuesday.
- Call the DPW Shop before noon on Mondays to schedule. (410) 272-1414.
- Place brush and limbs neatly cut side facing the road.
- No limbs or branches over 6 inches in diameter.
- Do not bundle with twine, rope or place in any container.

Bulk Waste

Bulk pick up is available at no cost, once a year. To schedule a call (410) 297-4259, and leave your Name, Address, Phone number and a list of items to be picked up. Or complete the online request form available at www.aberdeenmd.gov/edocs



Recycling Services

The City collects recycling weekly with trash. All recycling must be placed in a designated Toter for collection. Exceptions that may be left next to the recycling Toter for pick up are large pails, buckets, lawn furniture, toys, coolers and items that are acceptable but are too large to fit in the container.

The Single-Stream Recycling Program

To minimize health & safety risk please rinse all recycling containers.

Item	Acceptable	Not Acceptable
Paper	Juice boxes, milk and OJ cartons, junk mail, cereal boxes, office paper, newsprint, cardboard, paper bags, paperboard boxes	Paper towels or tissues, used paper plates or cups, gift wrapping paper, waxed or laminated paper, food-contaminated boxes, pizza boxes, diapers, sanitary products
Plastic	Plastic containers #1-#5 and #7. Bottles and jugs (shampoo, liquid soap, spray products etc.), disposable plastic cups, flower pots, buckets & pails, plastic lawn furniture, plastic coolers, laundry baskets.	#6 plastics, Styrofoam, cutlery, shopping bags, sheeting, CD and DVD cases, motor oil bottles, plastic electronics (alarm clocks, coffee maker etc.), piping, vinyl siding, medical syringes, "clamshells" (bakery, salad bar, berry etc.)
Metal & Glass	Aluminum & steel/tin cans (drink, food & pet food), EMPTY aerosol cans, aluminum foil, aluminum foil bake ware, glass food containers & beverage bottles & jars of any color.	Propane cylinders, window glass, cookware, ceramics (plates, mugs etc.), crystal, drinking glasses, light bulbs, mirrors.

Motor Oil/Antifreeze

Please follow instructions and keep the site clean.

Household Hazardous Waste

Health Care Items

Place needles, syringes, lancets, and other sharp objects in a hard plastic or metal container with a screw on or tightly secured lid. Reinforce the lid if necessary with heavy duty tape. Soiled bandages, disposable sheets, and medical gloves must be placed in securely fastened plastic bags before you put them in the designated Toter with your other trash.

Latex Paint (in cans)

Let paint dry up or mix in kitty litter or sand, and let it soak up, then bag the can, throw away in regular trash.
