Q1: The specifications state a 5% bid bond is required with the bid submission. With the quantities being undefined on the bid tabulation, what bond amount or total price should the contractor assume for bonding?

A1: For the purpose of determining a 5% bid bond amount, please use the cost per foot for 8" Mainline Pipe Lining, times 15,000 feet to get a total for the bid bond.

Q2: Would the owner confirm there are no prevailing wage requirements for this project? No prevailing wage will be required in the scope of this project

A2: No, there is no prevailing wage required in the scope of this project.

Q3: What are the normal work hours for this project? Will the contractor be responsible for inspector OT?

A3: Normal working hours are Monday – Friday, 7am to 5pm. No weekend, nights or holidays without expressed approval. Contractor will NOT be responsible for City staff or Inspector overtime.

Q4: Would the owner consider establishing a minimum thickness for CIPP liners due to the undefined scope & unknown depth of cover?

A4: No, a minimum thickness will not be incorporated into the scope at this time.

Q5: How is this project is going to be evaluated to be awarded since the bid form just lists out per foot and per day pricing. Would you be plugging in numbers for the expected first work order and seeing what the totals would be and then awarding to the bidder with the lowest total?

A5: The cost for each item on the bid form will be evaluated along with the other qualifying factors specified in the Bid docs and previous addenda. The project will not simply be awarded to the lowest bidder.
