Neighborhood block parties will be held on Sunday, September 6, 2026 (Labor Day Weekend).

Applications will be accepted beginning August 1, 2026, and must be received by 5:00 p.m. August 28, 2026.

Grants will be awarded on a first-completed, first-served basis until all ten grants have been awarded.

Approved applicants will receive their grant payment before September 2, 2026. Please complete all sections of this application.

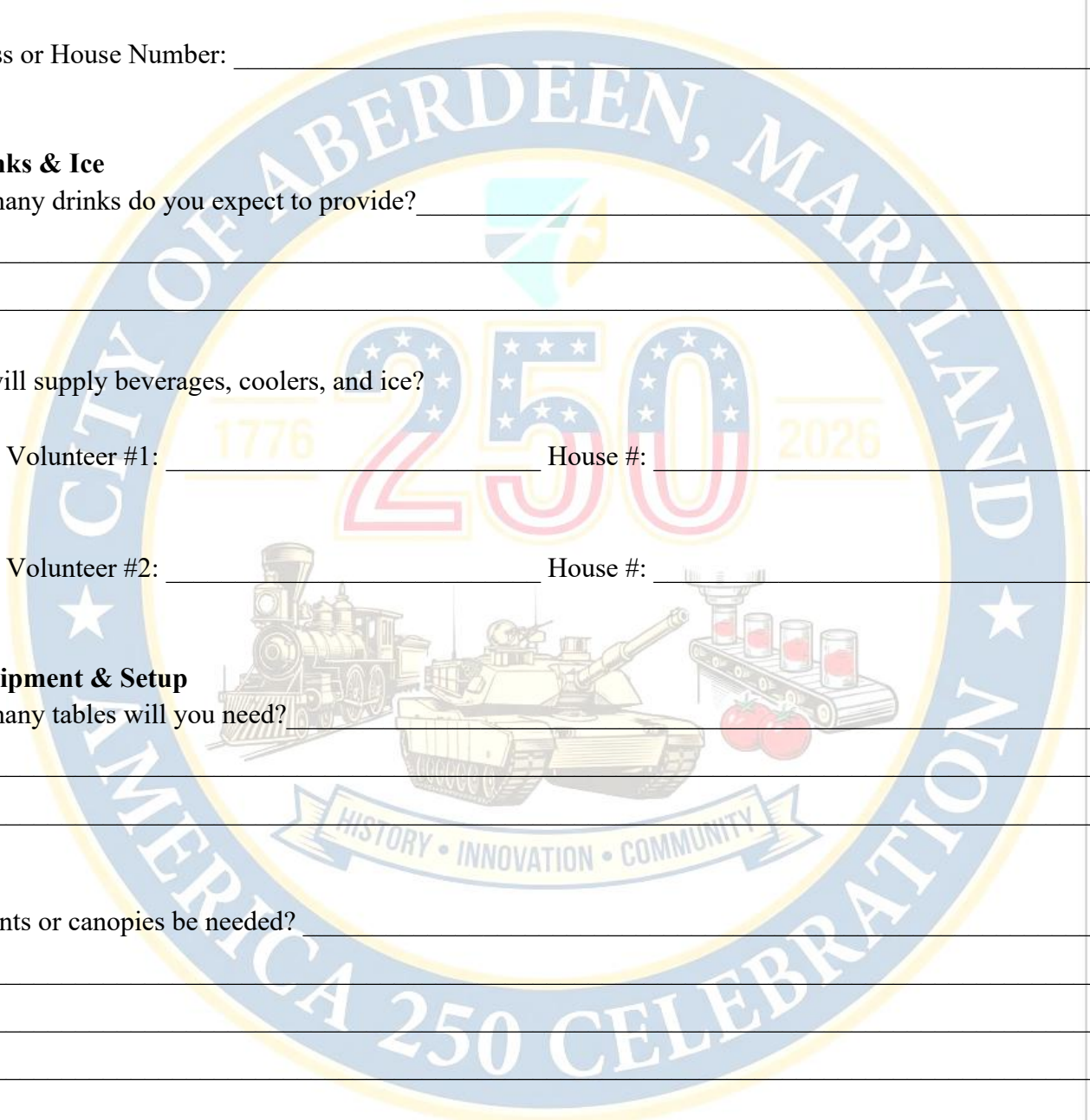
