Please see the questions and answers below concerning BID 25-03:

Q1: Is there a preferred format and/or page length for the outline of the proposed plan?

A1: No. For this professional services proposal, there is no preferred or required format.

Q2: Same question for the summary of previous experience. Also, is there a minimum or maximum number of references the City is looking for?

A2: There is no particular format required, but bidders should provide at least three references that would exemplify the product that the bidder would provide for Aberdeen.

Q3: Is it possible to eliminate the language about liquidated damages? Most of the construction stuff isn't a problem, but if there is liquidated damages language in the contract, there is always the possibility someone might want to enforce that if Arcadis delivered something late

A3: This project is time sensitive and liquidated damages are a standard provision that is necessary to keep projects on track. The project timeline will be agreed upon with the successful bidder and shall be reasonable enough to avoid damages. If any delays arise, that timeline can be adjusted as long as it is communicated properly with the City.
