- **Section 1: Answers to Questions Posed by Bidders**

**Section 1:**

**Q1:** What is the budget range for the mural project?

**A1:** The City of Aberdeen received a Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development Community Legacy grant in the amount of \$30,000 for the purpose of completing two murals on the pedestrian bridge structure at the Aberdeen MARC/Amtrak train station.

**Q2:** It looks like the selected artist would have from mid-July to November 1<sup>st</sup> to complete the project, is that correct?

**A2:** Once an artist is selected, the anticipated start date is mid-July. However, the City of Aberdeen is dependent on final approval from MDOT State Highway Administration before the project can commence. The mid-July start date is subject to change. November 1<sup>st</sup> is the anticipated completion date for the project, which is also subject to change.

**Q3:** Would the sidewalk have to be closed while the work is being done?

**A3:** The surrounding sidewalk area will need to be closed to accommodate the artist work zone. It is the responsibility of the artist to close off this area, as needed.

**Q4:** Are there any restrictions on the working hours?

**A4:** The normal working hours are from 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM ESDT, Monday – Friday. Alternate hours are permitted with prior written authorization by the City of Aberdeen.

**Q5:** Does the artist have to live in the Aberdeen area, since I currently live in Baltimore?

**A5:** No, the artist does not have to live in the Aberdeen area to submit a proposal.
