- Q1: Do you know if separate inventories will be required for COA's system and APG's system (both operated by the COA DPW)? Or does that need to be verified with MDE after the project awarding? We understand the proposed service costs need to be separated, but need clarification on whether one overall proposal is required to cover both systems, or two separated proposals.
- A1: The inventories for COA and APG shall be separate. The costs and proposals for each individual inventory shall also be separate.
- Q2: Our understanding is that funding opportunity exploration for lead/GRR service line replacement and/or on-going inventory preparation should be included in the scope. Please confirm or correct as needed.
- A2: The scope of this professional services agreement will be solely focused on the establishment and submittal of an initial inventory based on the records and historical documents requirements listed in MDE and EPA guidelines. In this initial phase, the selected firm shall research and assemble this information, compile the data into the format required by the State, then submit the initial inventory. The selected firm will liaise with the City and MDE to ensure all requirements for the initial inventory are satisfied, allowing the State to review the inventory and provide further requirements to comply with the LCRR. Anything beyond the establishment and acceptance of the initial inventory shall not be included in this scope.
