Memorandum for City Council

Subject: Bid No. 18-15 Krouse Elevated Water Tank Rehabilitation

- 1. The invitation to bid for the rehabilitation of the Krouse Elevated Water Tank located at Ray Avenue was issued on March 20, 2018 with bids closing on April 20, 2018. The City of Aberdeen received seven (7) sealed bids in response to invitation to bid No. 18-15. There were three (3) addendums issued.
- 2. The project consists of all labor, equipment, and materials for the complete preparation and coating of the interior and exterior surfaces, the installation of a mixer, removal of existing fence and placement of new perimeter fence, removal of existing control building and relocation of the electrical controls. Climb prevention devices (shields) shall be installed to the bottom 16 feet of each leg. Also included in the scope of work is minor repair, modification, and upgrade of metal structures to include seam welding, and patch plates.
- 3. The engineering services company, who prepared the project specifications, Century Engineering, has validated the proposal of the apparent low bidder and has confirmed the low bidder's expertise to perform this type of construction project.
- 4. The following is a compilation of the bids received:

5. The apparent low bid is within the city's authorized budget amount. The procurement office recommends to the council, that the contract for Bid No. 18-15 Krouse Elevated Water Tank Rehabilitation be awarded to the lowest competitive bidder, Horizon Bros. Painting Corp., with headquarters located in Howell, MI in the amount of \$344,945.00
