BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF 17 ABERDEEN that new §VIII.11 is amended and to read as follows: 18 19 § VIII. Finance and Taxation. 20 Real property that is the primary residence of each bona fide member of the Aberdeen 21 11. 22 Volunteer Fire Department, Inc., including bona fide life members, AND THE SURVIVING SPOUSES OF BONA FIDE LIFE MEMBERS, shall be exempt from 23 24 taxation for City purposed to the extent of \$45,000 assessed value. 25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABERDEEN that the date of adoption of this Resolution is August 26, 2013 and the 26 amendment of the Charter of the City of Aberdeen hereby enacted shall become effective on 27 28 October 15, 2013 unless a proper petition for referendum hereon shall be filed as permitted by 29 law, provided a complete and exact copy of this Resolution shall be continuously posted on the bulletin board in Aberdeen City Hall until October 5, 2013 and provided further that a copy of 30 the title of this Resolution shall be published in The Record, a newspaper of general circulation 31

in the City of Aberdeen, or in any other newspaper of such general circulation, once in each of the weeks beginning August 30, September 6, September 13, and September 20, 2013.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABERDEEN that the City Clerk is hereby specifically commanded to carry out the provisions of Section 2, hereof, and, as evidence of such compliance, the City Clerk shall cause to be maintained appropriate certificates of publication of the newspaper or newspapers in which the title of the Resolution shall have been published. If a favorable referendum is held on the Charter change, the Mayor shall proclaim the Charter change hereby enacted to have been approved by the voters and the charter amendment shall become effective on the date provided by law.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABERDEEN that as soon as the Charter Amendment hereby enacted shall become effective, either as provided herein or following a referendum, the City Clerk shall send by mail to the Department of Legislative Services of Maryland, a clear certified copy of this Resolution showing the number of Councilpersons voting for and against it and a report on the votes cast for or against the amendment hereby enacted at any referendum thereon and the date of such referendum.

The above Charter Amendment was enacted by the foregoing Resolution which was passed at a regular meeting of the Council of the City of Aberdeen on August 26, 2013, three (3) members of the Council voting in the affirmative, zero (0) members of the Council voting in the negative, two (2) members of the Council abstaining, and zero (0) members of the Council absent, and the said Resolution becomes effective accordance with the law on the 15th day of October, 2013.
