AN ORDINANCE concerning

ACCEPTANCE OF CURRY FAMILY TRUST GIFT

FOR the purpose of accepting a gift of two parcels of unimproved real property in the City of Aberdeen from the Curry Family Trust subject to certain conditions; authorizing the Mayor to execute a certain Deed of Gift accepting this gift on behalf of the City; and generally relating to the acceptance of a gift of land by the City of Aberdeen from the Curry Family Trust.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF

ABERDEEN, that it hereby accepts from the Curry Family Trust a gift of two parcels of unimproved parcels of land in the City of Aberdeen consisting of approximately .75 acres, more or less, located in the vicinity of Rogers Street, and described on Exhibit A to the Deed of Gift attached to this Ordinance and incorporated by reference. Acceptance of this gift is subject to the conditions contained in the Deed of Gift.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABERDEEN, that the Mayor is authorized to execute the Deed of Gift attached to this Ordinance on behalf of the City to evidence the City's acceptance of the gift.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABERDEEN, that this Ordinance shall become effective at the expiration of twenty (20) calendar days following adoption.

DEED OF GIFT

TOGETHER with the buildings and improvements thereupon erected, made or being, and all and every of the rights, alleys, ways, waters, privileges, appurtenances and advantages to the same belonging, or anywise appertaining.

BEING all of those lands conveyed by and described in a deed dated December 31, 1998, from Caroline M. Curry, Personal Representative of the Estate of G. DeWayne Curry, Deceased, to the Grantor and recorded among the Land Records of Harford County, Maryland at Liber No. 3583, folio 0346.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the above granted and described property unto Grantee, its successors and assigns, in fee simple, forever, subject to the following covenants personal to and enforceable only by Grantor:

- The Property shall be used for a park or similar public facility, the park or facility shall bear the name G. Dewayne Curry Memorial Park.
- The Property shall be held for public purposes. If the Property ceases to be held
 for public purposes Grantor may reenter the Property and Grantor at Grantor's
 cost shall seek re-conveyance of title in the Circuit Court for Harford County.

AND Grantor does hereby covenant to warrant specially the property herein described and conveyed and agrees to execute such further assurances as may be necessary.
