FOR the purpose of adding additional payment policies for hours of work and payment for overtime work for sworn officers of the Aberdeen Police Department.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABERDEEN that the Hours of Work and Payment for Overtime Work of the City of Aberdeen Personnel Policy Manual are amended as written below.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABERDEEN, that this Ordinance shall become effective at the expiration of twenty (20) calendar days following adoption.

HOURS OF WORK 1 The normal workweek is Sunday through Saturday and consists of 40 hours; the normal workday 2 consists of 8 hours for all employees except the Water and Waste Water Treatment Plants which 3 consists of rotating 8 and 12 hour shifts (including ½ hour paid meal period) AND SWORN 4 5 OFFICERS OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR WHOM THE CHIEF OF POLICE SHALL 6 DETERMINE OFFICER WORK SHIFTS. Since our payroll is on a bi-weekly basis, each pay period will consist of 80 hours, EXCEPT THAT FOR PURPOSES OF COMPUTATION OF 7 8 OVERTIME FOR AN OVERTIME-ELIGIBLE SWORN OFFICER OF THE POLICE 9 DEPARTMENT, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL HAVE A 14 CONSECUTIVE DAY WORK PERIOD THAT IS THE SAME AS THE CITY'S PAY PERIOD. The scheduling of special 10 hours will be determined, in advance, by each department head. 11 12 13 PAYMENT FOR OVERTIME WORK Regular employees: Hours worked in excess of the employee's scheduled workday (8 hours for 14 most employees, rotating 12 hours for employees of the water/wastewater treatment plants) or in 15 16 the excess of 40 hours per week are compensated at one and one-half times the employee's 17 regular hourly rate. For purposes of this calculation, "hours worked" include hours actually 18 worked by the employee and hours for which the employee receives vacation or sick leave. 19 20 SWORN OFFICERS OF ABERDEEN POLICE DEPARTMENT: HOURS WORKED BY AN OVERTIME-ELIGIBLE SWORN OFFICER OF THE ABERDEEN POLICE DEPARTMENT 21 22 IN EXCESS OF 80 HOURS IN AN 86 HOUR WORK PERIOD IS COMPENSATED AT ONE AND ONE-HALF TIMES THE EMPLOYEE'S REGULAR HOURLY RATE. FOR 23 24 PURPOSES OF THIS CALCULATION, "HOURS WORKED" INCLUDES HOURS 25 ACTUALLY WORKED BY THE EMPLOYEE AND HOURS FOR WHICH THE 26 EMPLOYEE RECEIVES VACATION OR SICK LEAVE. 27 Part-time/temporary employees: Overtime pay for part-time or temporary employees will be paid 28 29 only for hours actually worked in excess of 40 hours per week.
