1	BE IT ENACTED that the Code of the City of Aberdeen, Chapter 505, § 505-9A. and
2	B.(1) be and is hereby amended to read as follows:
3	§ 505-9. Bicycle Registration; Rules of Operation.

5	A. Registration. The owners of all bicycles maintained and operated within the corporate
6	limits of the City shall be required to obtain registration for said bicycle.
7	
8	B. A. Rules of operation; violations.
9	
10	(1) It shall be unlawful to operate a bicycle within the corporate limits of the City without
11	first registering the bicycle as provided herein. Any bicycle operated without having
12	first been registered shall be impounded by the Police Department until such
13	registration has been obtained.

15	(2) (1) The operation of bicycles shall apply to all bicycle operators, as set forth in the
16	Maryland Vehicle Law. Any violation of this section shall be cited in accordance with
17	the Maryland Vehicle Law.
