AN ORDINANCE concerning

AMENDMENTS TO CITY'S ETHICS ORDINANCE

FOR the purpose of repealing a particular form to be used for lobbying registration so that an appropriate form may be promulgated by the City's Ethics Commission; correcting a typographical error in a statutory reference in the City's ethics ordinance; and matters generally related to revisions to the City's ethics ordinance.

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SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF

ABERDEEN, that Sections 43-6.A. and 43-8.B.(2) of the Code of the City of Aberdeen (2010 Edition as amended), Chapter 43, Ethics, is amended to read as follows:

Chapter 43. ETHICS
§ 43-6. Lobbying.
A. A person shall file a lobbying registration statement ((<i>Editor's Note: The lobbying registration statement is included at the end of this chapter.</i>)) with the Ethics Commission if the person:
(1) Personally appears before a City official or employee with the intent to influence that person in performance of the official duties of the official or employee; and
(2) In connection with the intent to influence, expends or reasonably expects to expend in a given calendar year in excess of \$100 on food, entertainment or other gifts for officials or employees of the City.
§ 43-8. Enforcement.
B. Penalties
* * *
(2) If the Ethics Commission finds that a respondent has violated ((§ 7)) § 43-6 of this
chapter, the Ethics Commission may:
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SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF ABERDEEN, that this Ordinance shall become effective at the expiration of twenty (20)
calendar days following adoption.
