RESOLUTION NO. 13-R-01

**RESOLUTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF
INCURRING 3-YEAR DEBT FOR SEWER LINING EQUIPMENT**

1 **A RESOLUTION** for the purpose of authorizing the expenditure of monies in the FY 14, FY 15, and
2 FY 16 Capital Budgets to pay short term debt on a FY 13 purchase of equipment and supplies for the
3 lining of sanitary sewers within Aberdeen.

5 **WHEREAS**, the City of Aberdeen has systematically and affirmatively worked to reduce the impacts of
6 the inflow and infiltration (I&I) of rainwater and snowmelt into the sanitary sewer system owned by the
7 City; and

9 **WHEREAS**, the Mayor has proposed in FY 13 Capital Budget and the Council has approved a line item
10 for I&I mitigation in the amount of \$64,324 and the Mayor intends to continue to propose line items for
11 I&I mitigation in at least the levels of the FY 13 Capital Budget; and

13 **WHEREAS**, the City of Aberdeen Department of Public Works wishes to purchase equipment and
14 supplies so that it may employ an I&I mitigation technology referred to as "pipe bursting"; and

16 **WHEREAS**, the City has not budgeted enough in the FY 13 Capital Budget to buy all needed "pipe
17 bursting" equipment and supplies to begin to use this technology on the sanitary sewer lines within
18 Aberdeen; and

20 **WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council believe that it is in the best interest of the City to immediately
21 purchase all needed "pipe bursting" equipment with some supplies in the amount not to exceed \$96,000
22 so that the Department of Public Works can begin using this I&I mitigation technology beginning in FY
23 13 and that the City take out a short term loan to finance these expenditures.

25 **NOW, THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED** that it is the intent of the Mayor and Council of the
26 City of Aberdeen to borrow up to \$96,000 for a period not to exceed three (3) years for the purpose of
27 purchasing the needed equipment and some supplies for "pipe bursting" of the sanitary sewer lines within
28 Aberdeen.



32 Budgets.


