## **RESOLUTION NO. 13-R-01**

## RESOLUTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF INCURRING 3-YEAR DEBT FOR SEWER LINING EQUIPMENT

**A RESOLUTION** for the purpose of authorizing the expenditure of monies in the FY 14, FY 15, and FY 16 Capital Budgets to pay short term debt on a FY 13 purchase of equipment and supplies for the lining of sanitary sewers within Aberdeen.

WHEREAS, the City of Aberdeen has systematically and affirmatively worked to reduce the impacts of the inflow and infiltration (I&I) of rainwater and snowmelt into the sanitary sewer system owned by the City; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has proposed in FY 13 Capital Budget and the Council has approved a line item for I&I mitigation in the amount of \$64,324 and the Mayor intends to continue to propose line items for I&I mitigation in at least the levels of the FY 13 Capital Budget; and

WHEREAS, the City of Aberdeen Department of Public Works wishes to purchase equipment and supplies so that it may employ an I&I mitigation technology referred to as "pipe bursting"; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has not budgeted enough in the FY 13 Capital Budget to buy all needed "pipe bursting" equipment and supplies to begin to use this technology on the sanitary sewer lines within Aberdeen; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council believe that it is in the best interest of the City to immediately purchase all needed "pipe bursting" equipment with some supplies in the amount not to exceed \$96,000 so that the Department of Public Works can begin using this I&I mitigation technology beginning in FY 13 and that the City take out a short term loan to finance these expenditures.

**NOW, THERERFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED** that it is the intent of the Mayor and Council of the City of Aberdeen to borrow up to \$96,000 for a period not to exceed three (3) years for the purpose of purchasing the needed equipment and some supplies for "pipe bursting" of the sanitary sewer lines within Aberdeen.

**LET IT BE FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Mayor and Council will appropriate the needed funds to pay the principal and interest on the aforementioned loan in the FY 14, FY 15, and FY 16 Capital Budgets.
