A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ABERDEEN FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUPPORTING AND ACKNOWLEDGING THE HABITAT FOR HUMANITY PROJECT

The Mayor and City Council of Aberdeen, Maryland has approved a Sustainable Communities Plan and application and receipt of financing for a Community Legacy Project further described in the Community Legacy Application ("The Application" either directly by the Department of Housing and Community Development (the "Department") of the State of Maryland or through other departments or agencies of the State of Maryland.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of Aberdeen recognizes that there is a significant need for reinvestment and revitalization of the communities in Aberdeen; and

WHEREAS, Habitat for Humanity Susquehanna proposes to develop a Community Legacy Project (the "Project") as further described in the Application, the purpose of which will be to contribute to the reinvestment and revitalization in the Area; and

WHEREAS, the Department, either through Community Legacy or other programs of the Department, or in cooperation with other State departments or agencies, may provide some or all of the financing for the Project (the "Project Financing") in order to assist in making it financially feasible; and

WHEREAS, the applicable law and regulations require approval of a Sustainable Community, the Project, and the Project Financing by the Mayor and City Council of Aberdeen; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Mayor and City Council of Aberdeen endorses the Project, and, hereby approves the request for financial assistance in the form of a loan or grant up to the amount of \$30,000; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT copies of this Resolution are sent to the Secretary of the Department of Housing and Community Development of the State of Maryland.

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABERDEEN that this Resolution shall take effect from the date of its adoption.
