**RESOLUTION NO. 14-R-08**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ABERDEEN  
FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUPPORTING AND ACKNOWLEDGING  
THE INNER COUNTY OUTREACH PROJECT (THE "PROJECT")**

1   **WHEREAS**, Inner County Outreach (ICO), a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization, proposes to  
2   undertake a project through the Trinise Jones Summer Day Camp Program that will provide a  
3   summer learning environment for at-risk children from low-income and single-parent families  
4   (the "Project").

6   **WHEREAS**, this Project is designed to benefit children by preventing summer learning loss and  
7   enhancing the skills that they already possess. This Project also helps children gain or maintain  
8   the skills needed for the upcoming school year and is a gateway into other ICO programs such as  
9   mentoring and after school programs that help families address and assess their academic needs.  
10   The Project, in conjunction with other ICO programs, is designed to provide academic support to  
11   children throughout the entire year.

13   **WHEREAS**, the target population for the Project is at-risk youth in elementary, middle and high  
14   school who are residing in communities faced with low academic attainment, poverty and other  
15   risk factors such as gang activity and violence. This Project also serves those with limited access  
16   to transportation by providing transportation to and from camp, as well as to field trips.

18   **WHEREAS**, through the Project, the children will receive academic support for two hours each  
19   day, Monday through Thursday; field trips every Friday; swimming trips every Tuesday and  
20   Thursday; individual counseling during the seven week session (as per referral); daily physical  
21   education, arts electives, crafts and character building culminating in a three-day, two-night  
22   camping trip.

24   **WHEREAS**, employees involved in the Project as Teachers and Teacher's aides are required to  
25   pass an extensive background check, as well as an interview. Employees must also complete  
26   orientation and training prior to working with children in the summer camp program.

1   **WHEREAS**, Inner County Outreach has applied to the Department of Housing and Community  
2   Development of the State of Maryland for approval of the Project and an allocation of tax credits  
3   for business entities and individuals that contribute to the Project, under the Department's  
4   Community Investment Tax Credit Program.

6   **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Mayor and Council of the City of  
7   Aberdeen, hereby express support of the Project, as described above and urge the Department of  
8   Housing and Community Development to grant approval under the Community Investment Tax  
9   Credit Program.

11   **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this Resolution shall take effect from the date of its  
12   adoption.




