Except to the extent 10 that the City has retained any power or authority, or allocated duties and 11 responsibilities to another fiduciary, said Committee shall have full power and 12 13 authority to administer and operate the Plan in accordance with its terms and in particular the authority contained in Sections 53 through Section 61, and, in acting 14 15 pursuant thereto, shall have full power and authority to deal with all persons in any matter directly connected with the Plan, including, but not limited to. the 16 Trustees, other fiduciaries, insurance companies, investment advisors, other 17 advisors and specialists, Participants, Beneficiaries and their representatives, in 18 19 accordance with the following provisions: 20 21 Individuals serving on the Committee (a) 22 23 The Committee shall consist of those individuals who hold the following 24 positions in the employment of the City: 25 26 (1)City Manager; 27 Director of Finance; (2) 28 Human Resources Administrator; (3) 29 (4) Sworn police officer; and Sworn police officer. 30 (5) 31 The Committee members who serve the City as sworn police officers shall be 32 selected by the Committee based on the recommendations of the Chief of Police 33 34 of the City. 35 Compensation, acceptance of duties and responsibilities 36 (b) 37 Subject to his or her right to resign at any time, each member of the Committee 38 shall serve without compensation at the pleasure of the City, and the City may 39 appoint, and may revoke the appointment of, additional members to serve with the 40 Committee as may be determined to be necessary or desirable from time to time. 41

Each member of the Committee, by accepting appointment to the Committee,

shall thereby be deemed to have accepted all of the duties and responsibilities of

such appointment, and to have agreed to the faithful performance of his or her
