**RESOLUTION NO. 16-R-08**

**COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDS PLAN FOR USE**

1 **WHEREAS**, the City of Aberdeen has established and maintained a Revolving Loan Program  
2 established with Federal Community Development Block Grant funds received from the State of  
3 Maryland through the Department of Housing and Community Development and the Department  
4 of Business and Economic Development; and

5  
6 **WHEREAS**, the City of Aberdeen has been contacted by the State of Maryland Department of  
7 Housing and Community Development about using the funds from the under-utilized program  
8 for other eligible Community Development Block Grant activities; and

9  
10 **WHEREAS**, the City of Aberdeen has considered a wide range of activities; and

11  
12 **WHEREAS**, the City Council has held the required public hearing to assist with the  
13 determination of how the funds should be spent; and

14  
15 **WHEREAS**, the City Council understands and acknowledges that they would be responsible for  
16 completion of grant activities and any corrective actions including the repayment of funds if  
17 necessary.

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City Council has approved the use of  
20 **\$283,886.11** of funds for the following projects:



22 1. Construct two (2) bus shelters – one at Center Deen Avenue and Old Post Road and one  
23 at West Bel Air Avenue and U.S. 40 adjacent to Amtrak/MARC Train Station, estimated  
24 cost of **\$30,000.**  
25  
26 2. Repave the parking lot at the Aberdeen Family Swim Center, estimated cost of **\$35,680.**

3. Add twenty (20) trash receptacles throughout the City at a cost of \$11,200.
4. Install new playground equipment, multiple police cameras, and fencing on City-owned property, 15 E. Bel Air Avenue, estimated cost of \$85,000.
5. Boys & Girls Club of Harford County upgrades to interior lighting in gymnasium, estimated cost of \$15,000.
6. Repaving the following streets in east Aberdeen: Old Post Road and Victory Street, estimated cost of \$46,006.11.
7. Harford County Aberdeen Branch of the library install drop box, estimated cost of \$7,500.
8. Aberdeen Parks and Recreation wrestling mats and half the cost of hoists, estimated cost of \$16,000.
9. Upgrades to North Deen Park Roller Rink, estimated cost of at \$10,000.
10. Three portable Aluminum Bleachers for North Deen Park, estimated cost of \$3,000.
11. Two portable basketball hoops for Aberdeen Parks and Recreation, estimated cost of \$8,000.
12. Two storage containers at North Deen Park, estimated cost of \$4,000.
13. Security cameras at North Deen Park, estimated cost of \$12,500.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Mayor is authorized and empowered to enter in an agreement with the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development and execute any and all documents required for the management of these funds.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this Resolution shall take effect from the date of its adoption.




