Aberdeen is the largest municipality in Harford County with a current population of 15,856. The City of Aberdeen is the employment center of Harford County, with Aberdeen Proving Ground as the largest employer. The U.S. Army mega base – Aberdeen Proving Ground is located on our borders and its scientific and technical workforce has brought a CHANGE IN DEMOGRAPHICS to Aberdeen and Harford County. Aberdeen Proving Ground employs 21,000. Aberdeen is strategically located off I-95 in the Greater Baltimore Region of the mid-Atlantic United States markets. Our location provides direct access to major markets in Philadelphia, Baltimore, and Washington, D.C. One third of the U.S. population can easily be reached from Aberdeen, Maryland. Direct linkages to this transportation network have been a major force in shaping the City's growth. Aberdeen is the home of C&S Wholesale Grocers, Frito Lay, Inc., Medline Industries, Inc., Saks Fifth Avenue, Prime Source, Northrop-Grumman, Home Depot, Walmart, and Target. We offer new residential construction with single family developments, such as Eagles Rest and Fields at Rock Glenn and new multi-family developments such as The Yards at Fieldside Village and Summerlin. 
