

## Waste Collection Update

CITY STAFF WILL CONTINUE TO SERVICE TRASH AND RECYCLING TO OUR RESIDENTS. ACTIONS TO PURSUE A CONTRACT WITH GFL ENVIRONMENTAL WERE PAUSED IN JUNE. ON MONDAY, AUGUST 2, 2021 THERE WILL BE A CHANGE TO THE TRASH AND RECYCLING SCHEDULE. NOTABLY, THERE ARE THREE MAJOR CHANGES OUTLINED BELOW.

1. <u>New Zones</u> - To our long-time residents, the City has collected trash in a four zone Monday through Thursday schedule. With the addition of a fifth zone, some residents will continue to remain on their scheduled day, while others will move to a new collection day. Residents in the Zones 1 and 2 for example, will see no change on their collection days. Residents that live in the existing Zones 3 and 4 will be affected. The table below is a summary with the map. A detailed map is located on Page 2 of this newsletter as well as on our website at <a href="https://www.aberdeenmd.gov">www.aberdeenmd.gov</a>.

New Zone	Pick Up	Collection Areas
1	Mon	Downtown Area - Edmund, Law, Rogers, Market, Custis, etc.
2	Tue	Examples: Baltimore St, Mt Royal Ave, Baker St, Hillman Ct, Paradise Rd, Graceford Dr, Plater St, Alton Homes, Woodland Greens Neighborhoods, Chapel Glen Area, and Northeast Rd
3	Wed	Aberdeen Hills (North), Barnette Lane, Maxa Woods, Ramsgate Area
4	Thu	All Deen areas, Rock Glen neighborhoods, Barkess and Farm Road, Windemere Subdivisions, and Hillcrest Area.
5	Fri	Swan Meadows and East Side – Examples: Aberdeen Ave, Darlington Ave, S Post Rd, Polk St, Winston's Choice, Church Green, E Bel Air Ave.

- 2. Yard Waste There will be no yard waste collection in August and September. The next collection date for the entire City will be Saturday October 16, 2021. Additional collection dates are Saturday, November 20, 2021 and Saturday, December 18 2021. Residents may bring their yard waste to Harford County Mulch and Compositing Facility at 3241 Scarboro Rd, Street, MD 21154 at <a href="https://www.harfordcountymd.gov/">https://www.harfordcountymd.gov/</a> at no charge. Residents should contact (410) 698-3018 for additional information if one of these collection dates does not meet your needs.
- <u>3. Bulk Waste</u> There is no change to bulk policy for an annual "free" pick up. Residents are required to contact the Bulk waste line at (410) 297-4259 for scheduled pick up. You must call and be scheduled, otherwise the items will not be picked up. Scheduled dates will now vary.

### **Need a New Trash Can Toter?**

Aberdeen residents with damaged, stolen, or missing City of Aberdeen Toters should follow the simple steps below to obtain repairs or a new COA Toter.

- Damaged Toter Call our Environmental Department at 410-272-2232. A City employee will come out and assess the damaged COA Toter to determine if repairs can be made or if a new COA Toter is needed.
- **Stolen or Missing Toter** Report stolen or missing COA Toters to the Aberdeen Police Department at 410-272-2121. After you receive a police report number, call our Environmental Department at 410-272 -2232, give them the Police Report Number to obtain a new Toter.

### Aberdeen Rolls Out the Red Carpet for Horizon

Recently, Mayor Patrick McGrady, the Aberdeen City Council, and staff had the long-overdue privilege of formally welcoming Horizon Cinemas to our city. Horizon originally opened back in March 2020 and was subsequently forced to shutter its doors as the COVID-19 pandemic surged across the United States. The theater would reopen later that year, hamstringed by capacity limitations and a lack of new films coming out of Hollywood. Despite all these setbacks, Horizon innovated with drive-in theater options, partnerships with Ripken Stadium, and the return of classics to the big screen like Star Wars and Hocus Pocus. Horizon has weathered the storm and is now fully-operational, complete with eight theater screens, reclining seating, a full-service bar, and an assortment of food on the menu. 
### Old Aberdeen High School Transformation On the Way!

The old Aberdeen High School, a historic piece of architecture that harbored generations of young minds, will receive a breath of new life after years of disuse and decay. Vascular Surgeon Dr. Mohammed Chaudry and his partner will be transforming the school structure into Nova Vascular: a comprehensive medical treatment center specializing in vascular and diabetic wound care. With Upper Chesapeake on the way and the new Nova Vascular facility in the works, Dr. Chaudry envisions Aberdeen as a hub for advanced medical care in northeastern Maryland.

### The Edge at Middelton

We're excited to report a new apartment development, the Edge at Middleton, will be constructed at 800 Beards Hill Road. The apartments will be built on a 10+ acre plot of land and will consist of 87 one-bedroom units, 137 two-bedroom units, and 13 three-bedroom units for a total of 237 units. The proposed amenities include a dog park, club house, swimming pool, and garage parking.
