* In 2023, Aberdeen's water and sewer utilities are funded at **\$18,168,055**. Like most cities in Maryland, the Aberdeen systems are classified as Enterprise funded operations. This essentially requires them to be self-funded and not use tax dollars to finance their operations.

** In 2023, Ripken Stadium is budgeted at **\$493,200** which includes transfers from the General Fund of \$66,648. This Fund is not fully self-funded and uses tax dollars to fund most of its operations.
